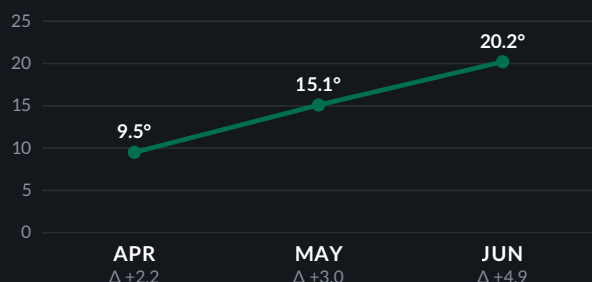

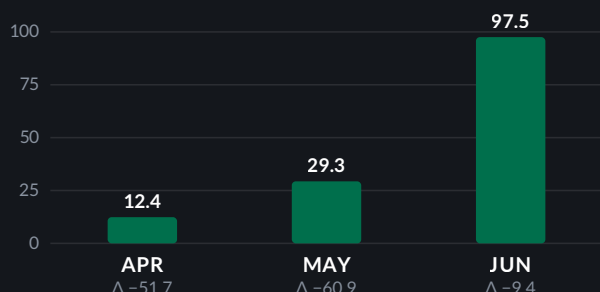

■ CURRENT SITUATION

HALLERTAU

GERMANY

- As of the end of June, year-to-date precipitation stands at 280.6 mm — 33.5 % below the long-term average.
- Until mid-month the stands looked very healthy and were about one week ahead in development. The heat days of the past week markedly slowed this lead; growth came almost to a standstill.
- The high temperatures are already causing initial damage; in the top canopy the main bines are partially dying back. This will affect the yields of the 2026 harvest going forward. The Herkules variety is currently the most affected.
- With 12 heat days, June 2026 marks a new record high; the previous record was 11 heat days in 2003.
- Thanks to the heat, downy mildew is not a concern, while powdery mildew appears sporadically. Aphid treatments were carried out successfully. Following the recent rainfall, spider mite treatments will become necessary again.

SLOVENIA

SLOVENIJA

- In early June, a hailstorm damaged hop stands over an area of roughly 400 ha. We are monitoring further development in order to estimate the extent of the damage and how far the stands can recover.
- Precipitation and the irrigation situation through the end of June are in order. Due to the very high temperatures of the past week, growers have begun irrigating again.
- The plants are in good condition. Downy mildew, red spider mite and other potential diseases are under control.

CZECH REPUBLIC

ČESKO

- Toward the end of the month it was also very hot in the Czech Republic. Early in the month there was relatively strong downy mildew pressure, which could nevertheless be kept under control.
- Some stands are weaker this year than last year.
