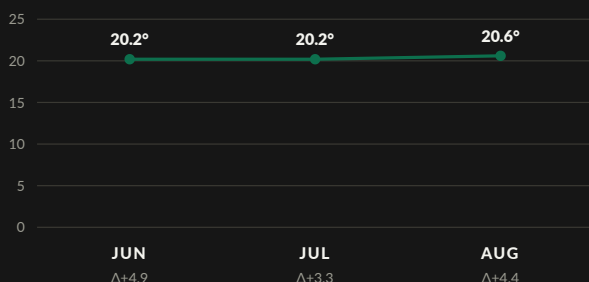

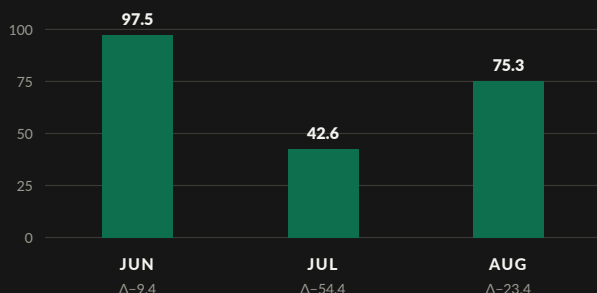

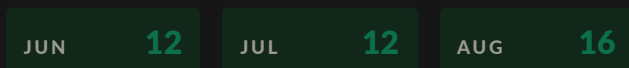

GERMANY

- The 2026 hop harvest has begun. A total of 46 heat days were recorded from May through August – the highest figure on record.
- August averaged 20.6 °C, 4.4 °C above the long-term mean, with temperatures exceeding 30 °C on 16 days.
- Rainfall reached 75.3 mm in August, 23.4% below the long-term monthly average.
- Year-to-date rainfall stood at 398.5 mm by the end of August, 35.5% below the long-term average.
- The persistent heat affected the crop. Detailed production figures are available in the harvest estimate sent last week.

- Temperatures were again very high. Growers report that rain in the second half of August came too late for early varieties.
- Some flowers failed to develop further, resulting in incomplete cone formation in places.
- The published crop figure based on IHGC data from late July is now expected to be missed.

CZECH REPUBLIC

- August was also too hot and dry in the Czech Republic to support a good crop.
- Although the cones appear healthy and large, some of the vine tips have been scorched.
